




# EPIDEMIOLOGY IN ARGENTINA


- **0.3 %** HIV prevalence
- **6500** new infections in 2017
- **2.3** men for each women 
- **32.7%** is diagnosed in an advanced stage
- **3.6** deaths per 100000 inhabitants









**CONCLUSIONS: 70%** PEOPLE HIV+ AWARE / **81%** RECIEIVING ARV TREATMENT / AROUND **50%** HAVE SUPPRESSED VIRAL LOAD

We need better state-funded population and controlled studies. Besides there are others unresolved economical and political issues that avoid improvement in our health situation**
