




- 32.7% is diagnosed in an advanced stage

70% is aware of **HIV** diagnosis 85400 people


30% is not aware of HIV diagnosis 36600 people


81% of those who are aware are in **ARV** treatment 69200 people



7 of 10 people are treated in the public health care system






