Combination Prevention

The national cohort review of women newly diagnosed with HIV has been launched by Maria Jesus Perez. A great response from all WAVE members and other EACS members means we hope to have the results by June.

A questionnaire for women on PrEP is being drafted.

The literature review results will be presented at the WAVE workshop. In the second half of the year, we will invite you to respond to a survey on co-infections and co-morbidities in women in your practice.
