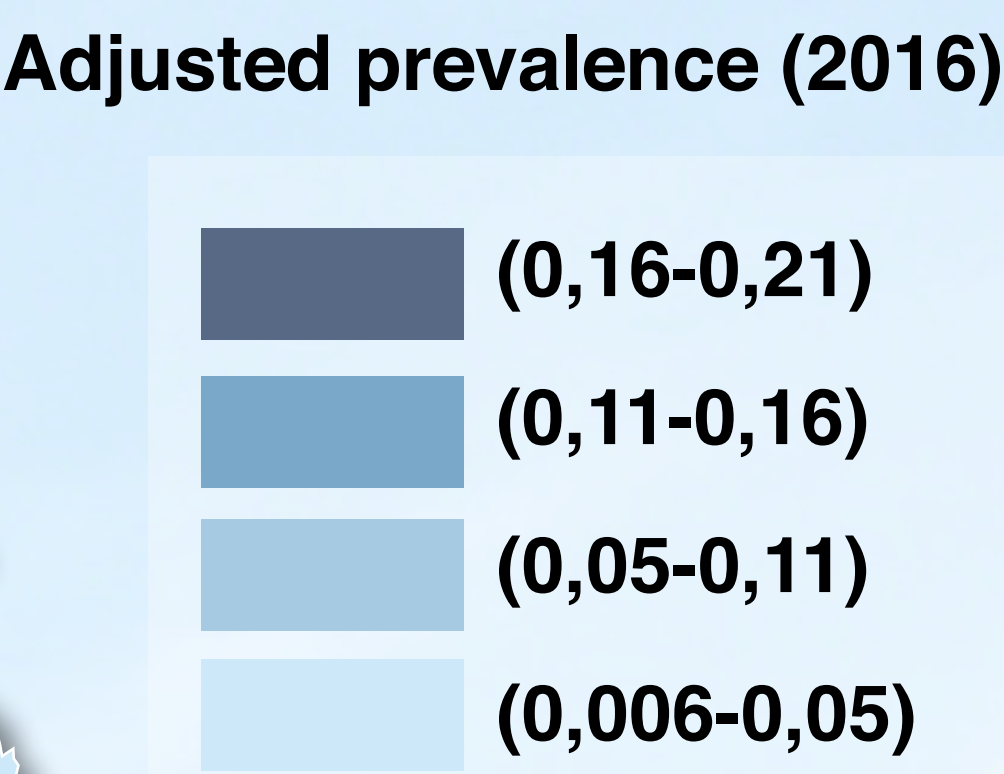

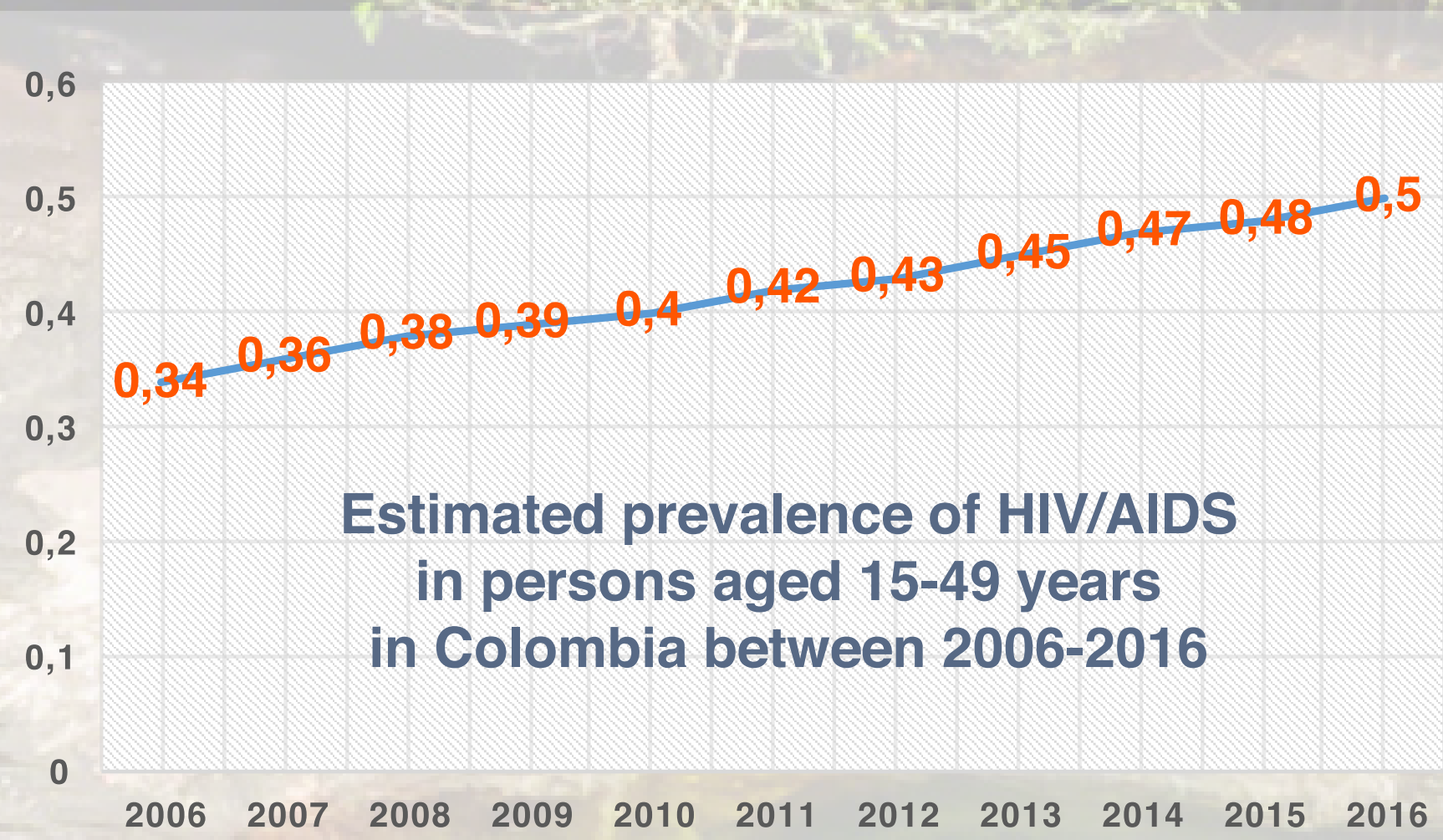
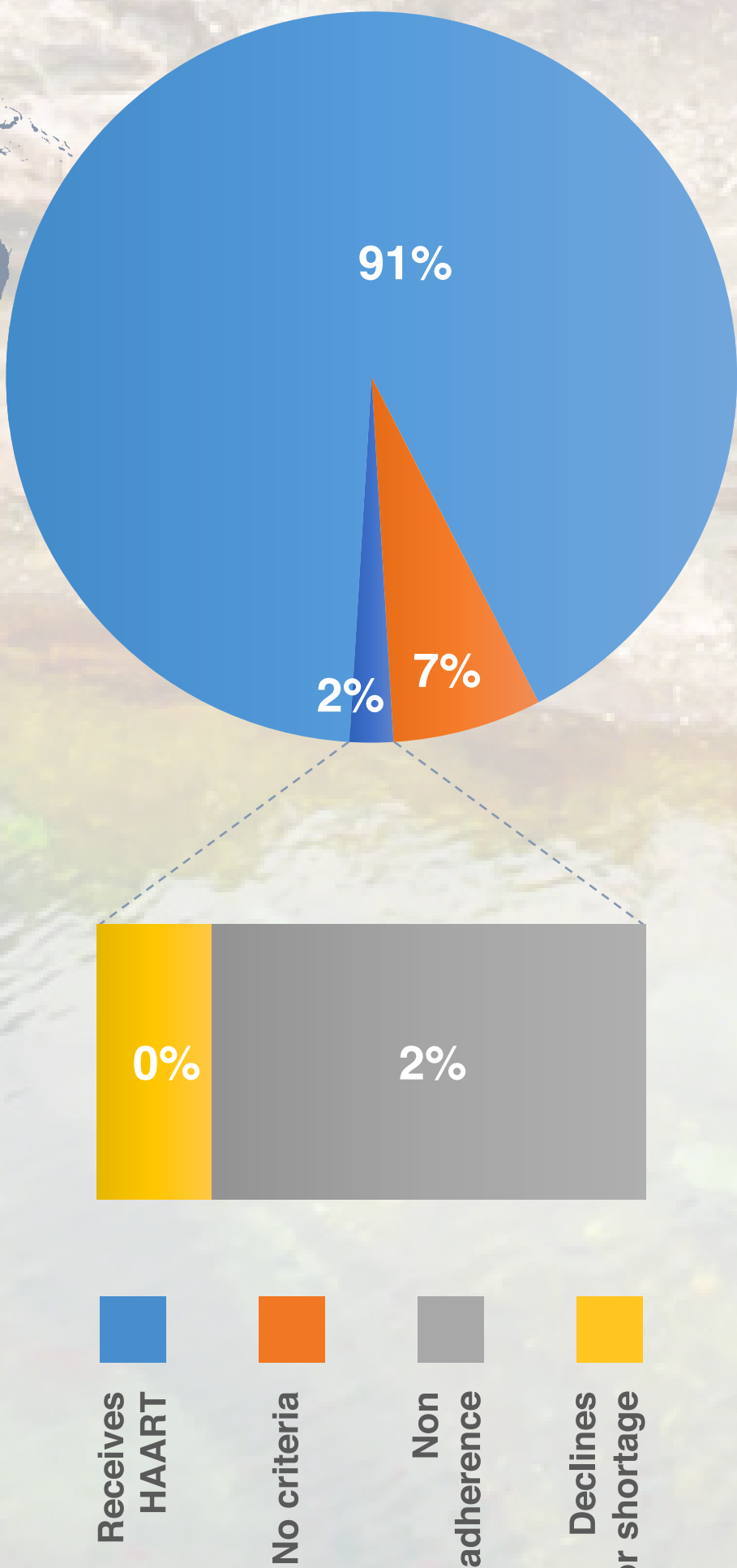

Prevalence in pregnant women: **0,12%**



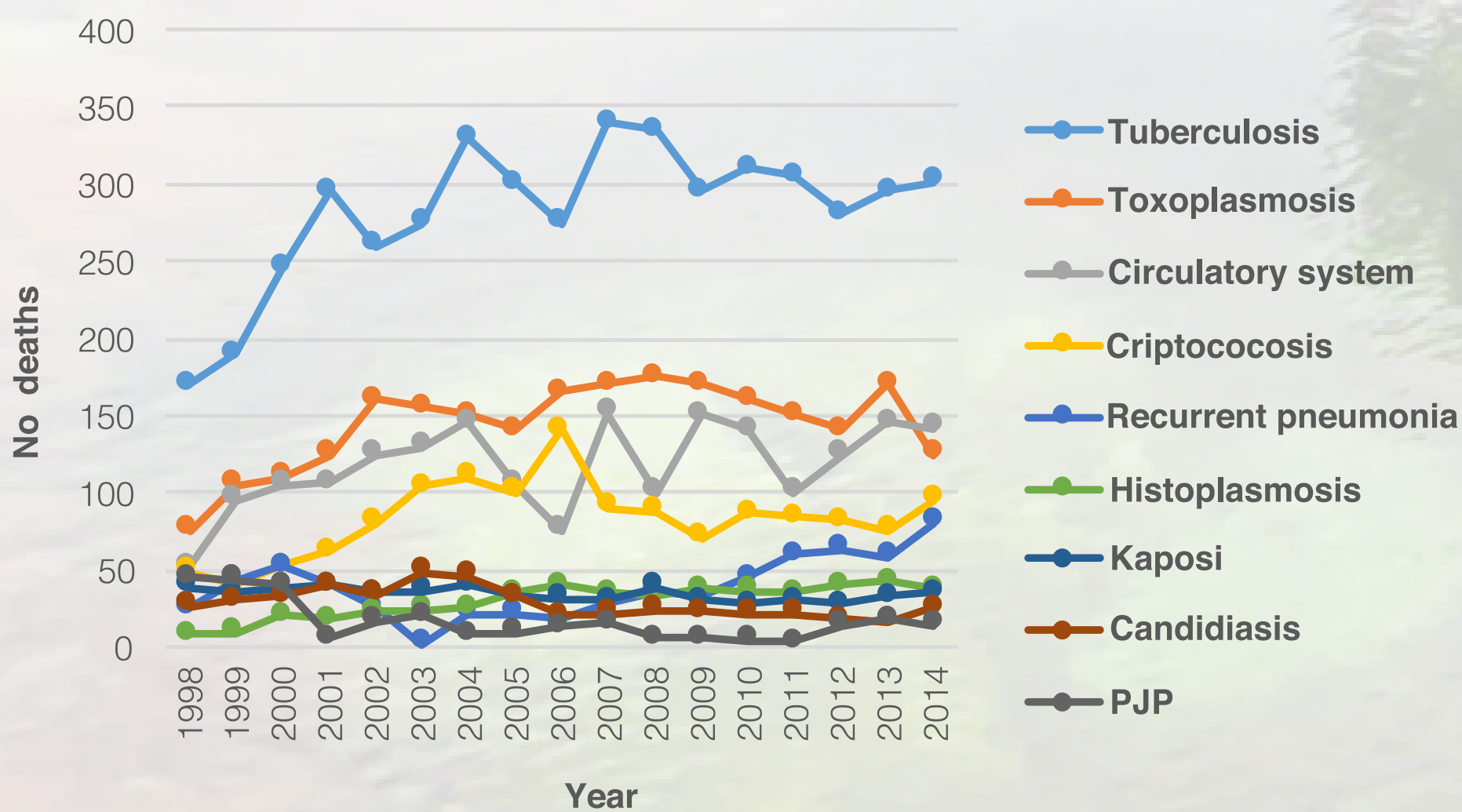

HIV epidemic in Colombia is concentrated, it has a prevalence less than 1% in general population aged 15 to 49 years, and more tan 5% in certain key populations.

Distribution of underlying causes of death in patients with HIV / AIDS, Colombia 1998-2014

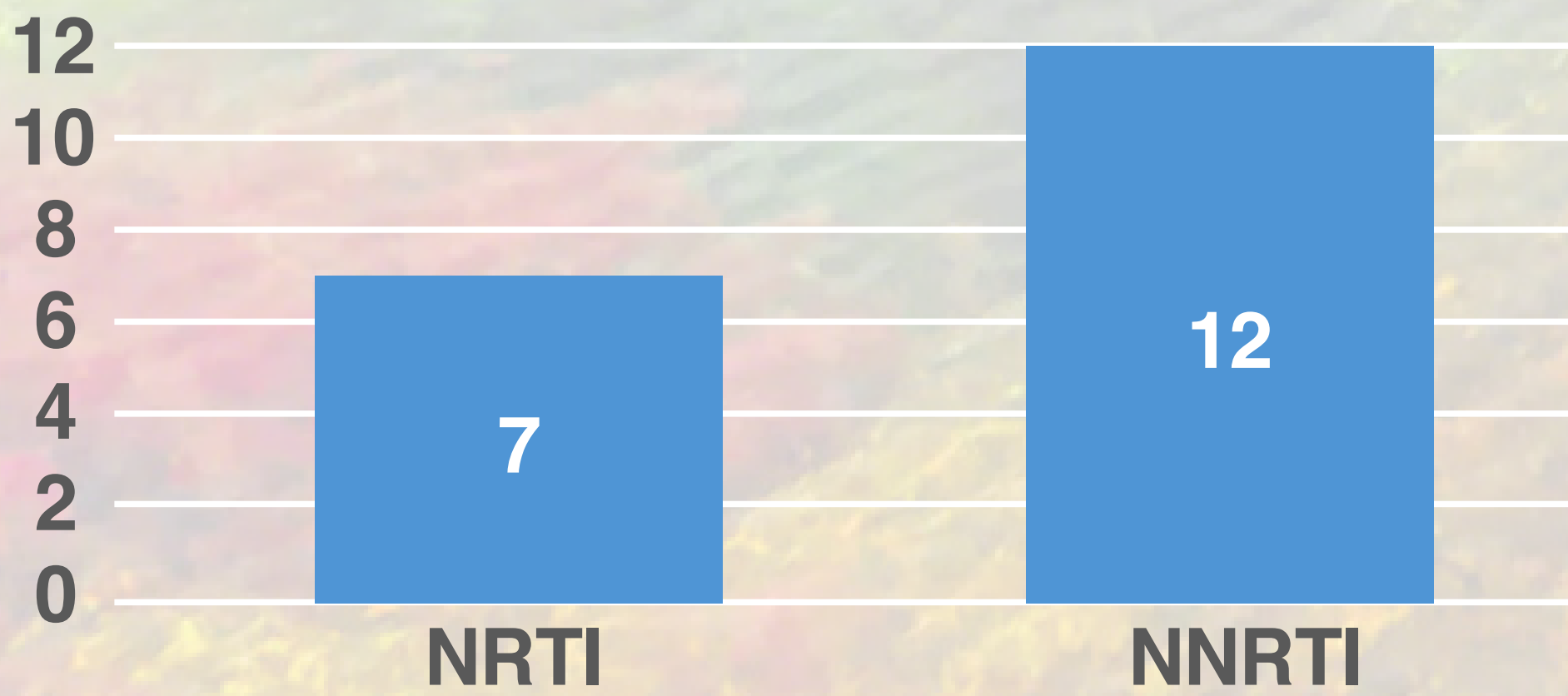

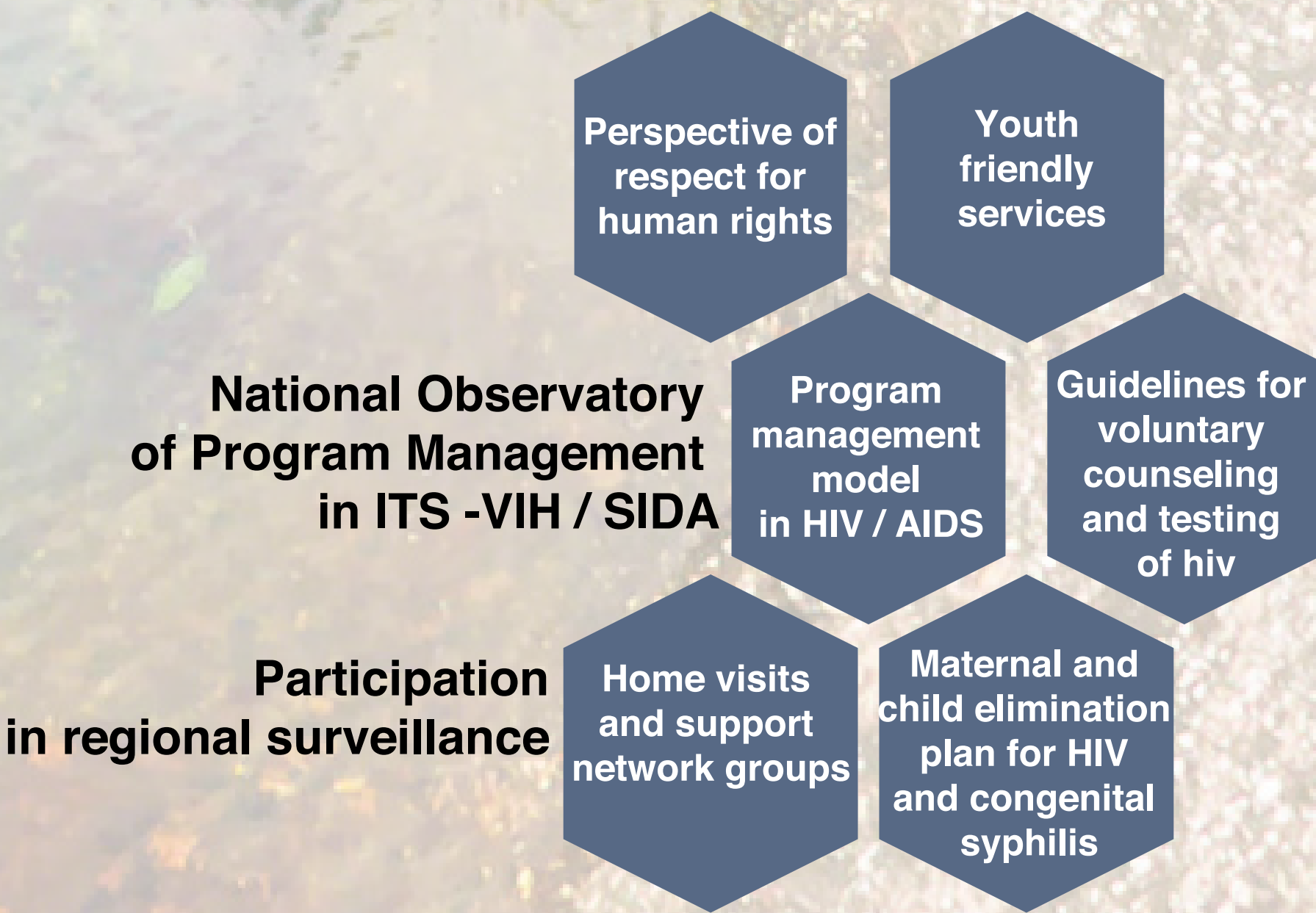
Trasmitted resistance in Colombia*
