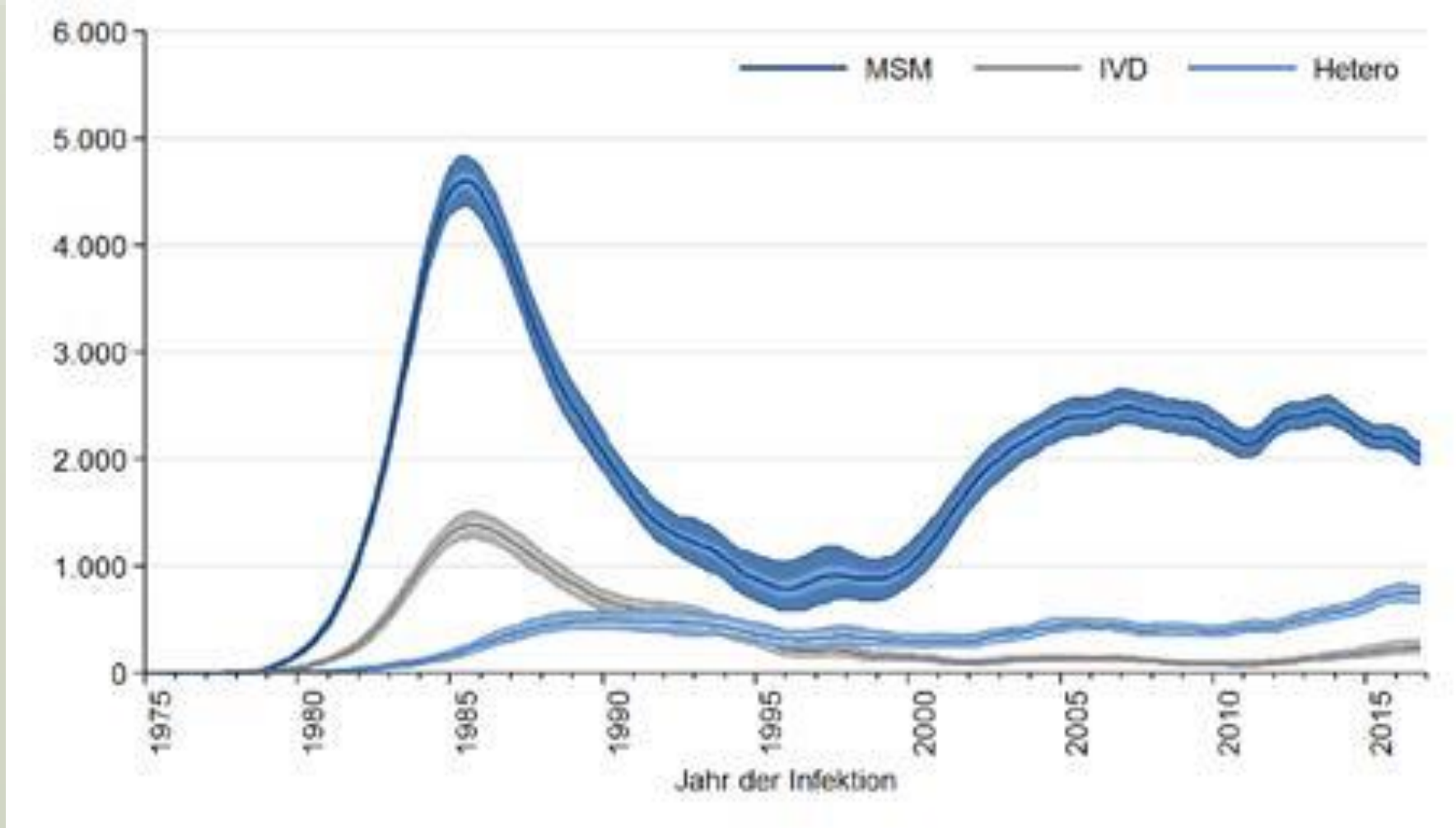

- Decreasing new infections under MSM
- Increasing number of new infections under i.v. drug users and due to heterosexual transmission
- Resistance becomes a minor problem
- Still around 12.700 seropositive people do not know their status

What can be improved

- Improvement of accessibility to HIV tests (not only for doctors) may reduce the amount of late diagnosis
- PrEP is easily available now, but will it decrease the amount of new infections? Or will it result in more STDs due to less condom use?
- Still discrimination of HIV seropositives (e.g. at the dentist)
- Compliance is a daily issue at the out patient clinic
