Standard of Care meeting 2019

- Date: 30-31 January, 2019
- Venue: National Institute for Infectious Diseases "Prof. Dr. Matei Bals", Bucharest, Romania Report
- Chair: Cristiana Oprea
- Attendees: 89 participants, representing 30 countries
- Profile: PLWHIV, Community representatives, and public health institutional partners, such as ECDC, WHO, UNAIDS, and HIV in Europe.





Standard of Care Audit project

Three key areas

- 1. Diagnosis and treatment hepatitis C virus (HCV) coinfection
- 2. HIV testing and late presentation
- 3. Integration of HIV-TB services

Pilot project

Hep audit in 5-6 countries: Georgia, Germany, Poland, Romania, Spain.

ECDC helps with the data analysis.

The first **results** of the pilot will be presented at the **EACS 2019** Conference at the **Standard of Care session** in Basel on **Saturday**, 8 November 2019.

Russian clinicians with the support of WHO interested in participating to a late presenters audit.

ECDC Scoping project

ECDC has approched EACS for a Scoping project to develop European Standards of HIV care.

Purpose: To support ECDC in conducting a scoping exercise that considers the span and perceived usefulness of a European Standards of HIV Care, taking into account public health, clinical and community perspectives.

Scope: To identify and analyse useful sources of background information, draft key areas for possible inclusion in a European Standards of Care.

Timeframe: 12 months


