

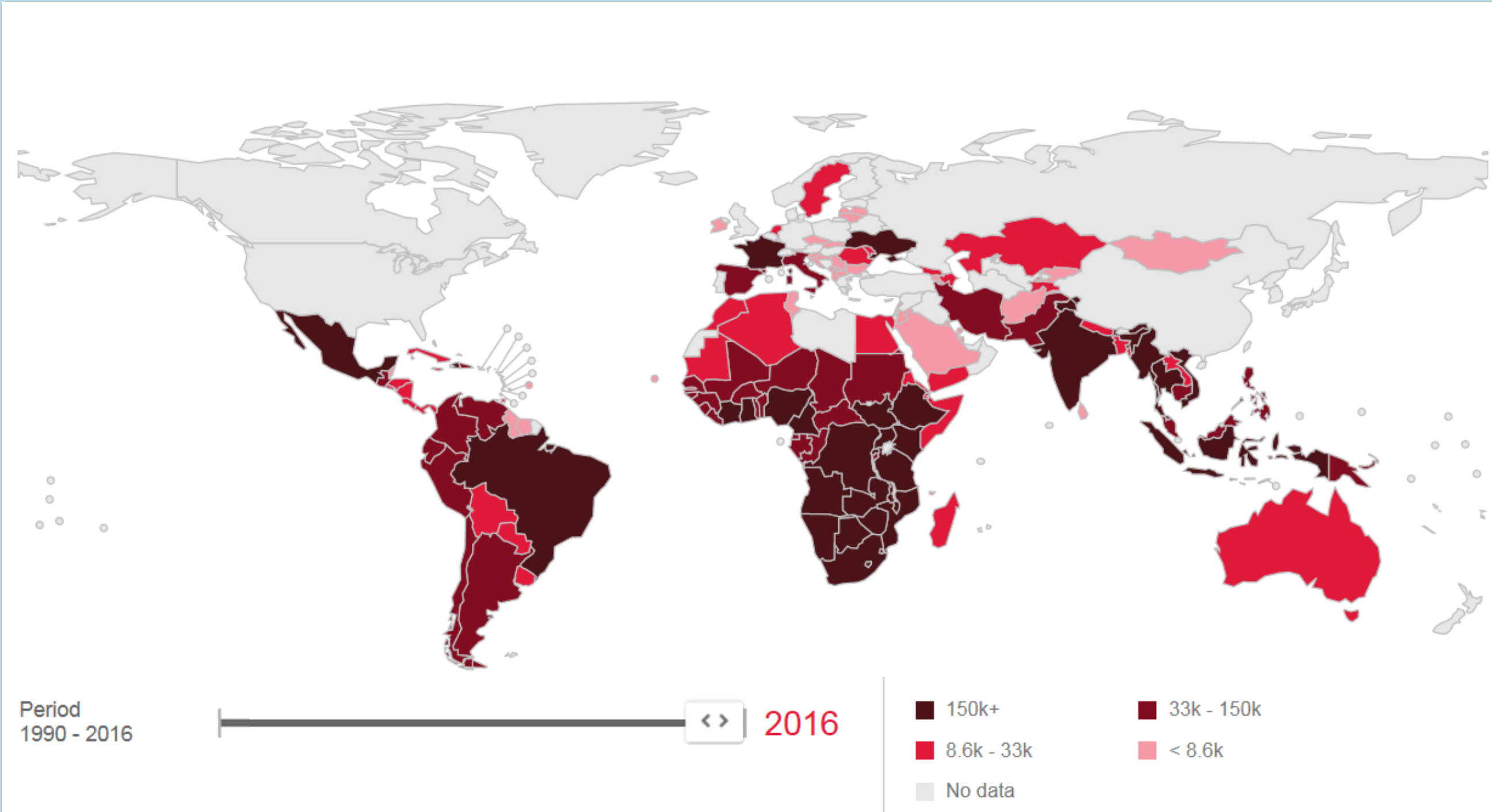

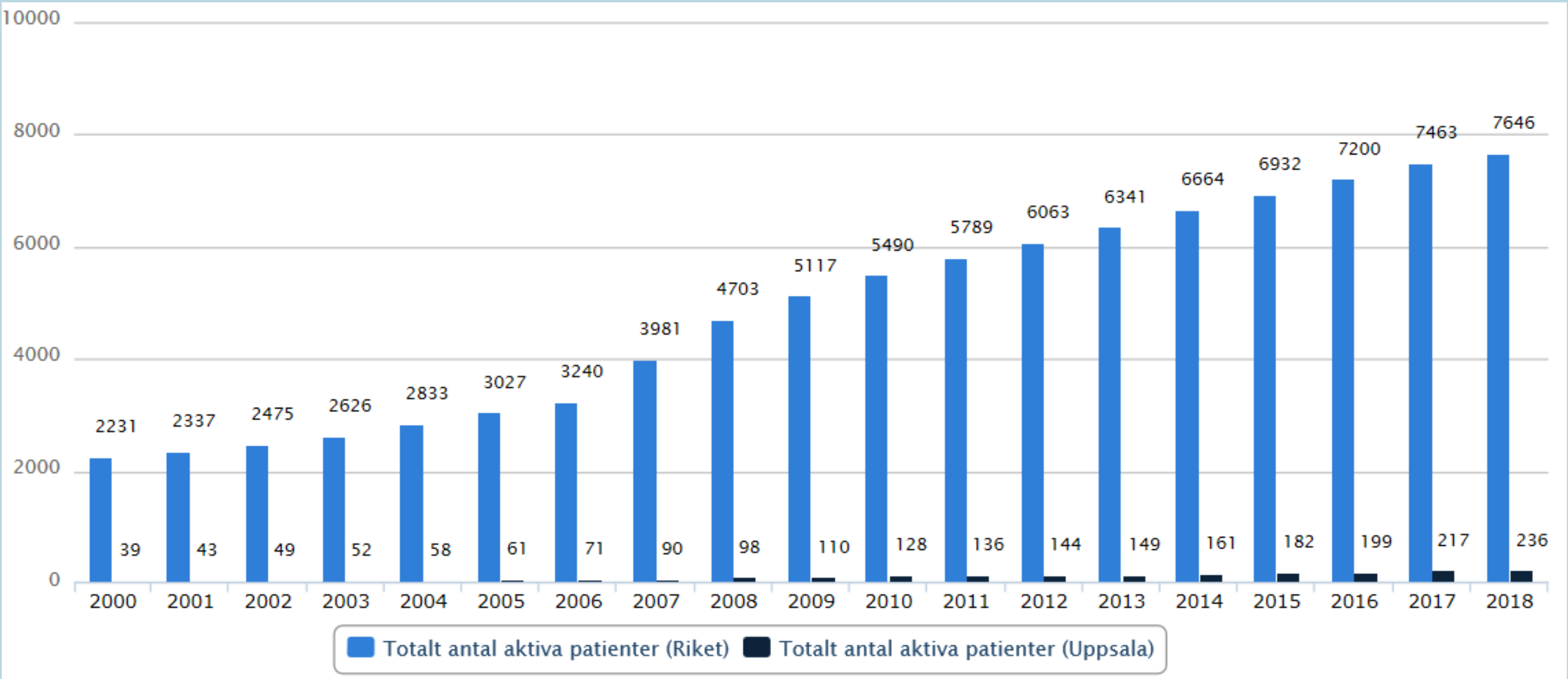

The hiv epidemic

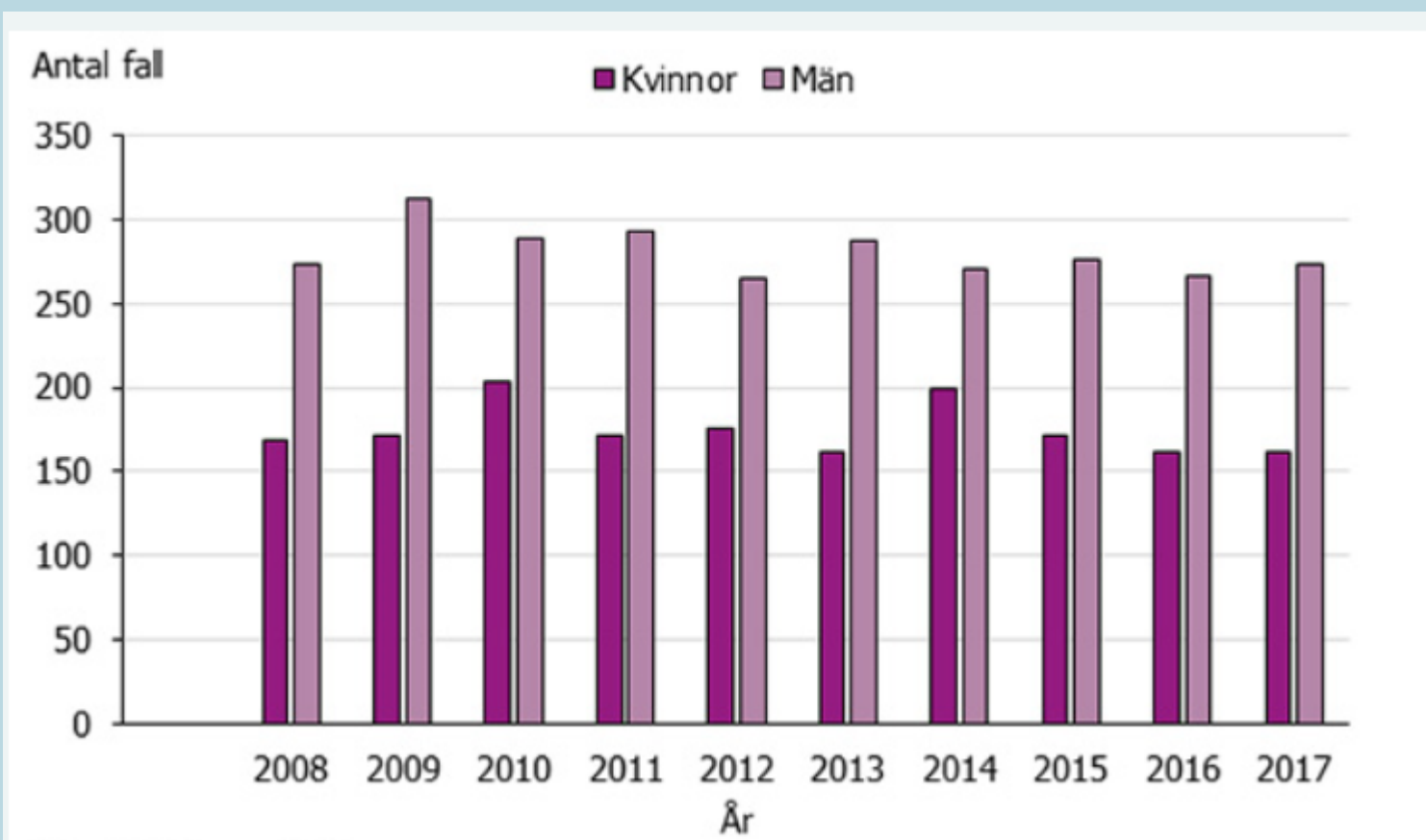


Hiv incidence 4.3/100 000 inhabitants

7646 hiv patients

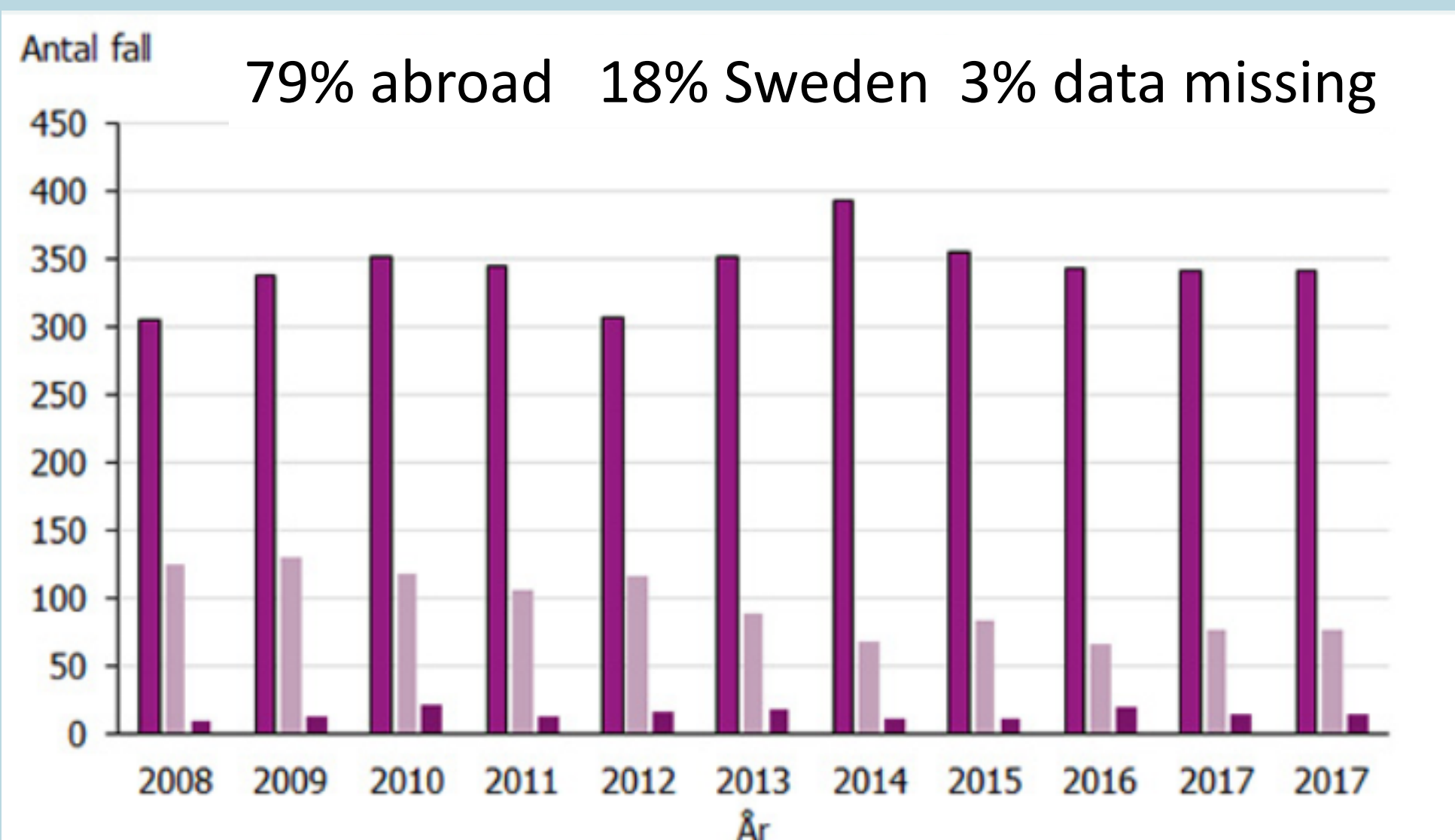


Transmission



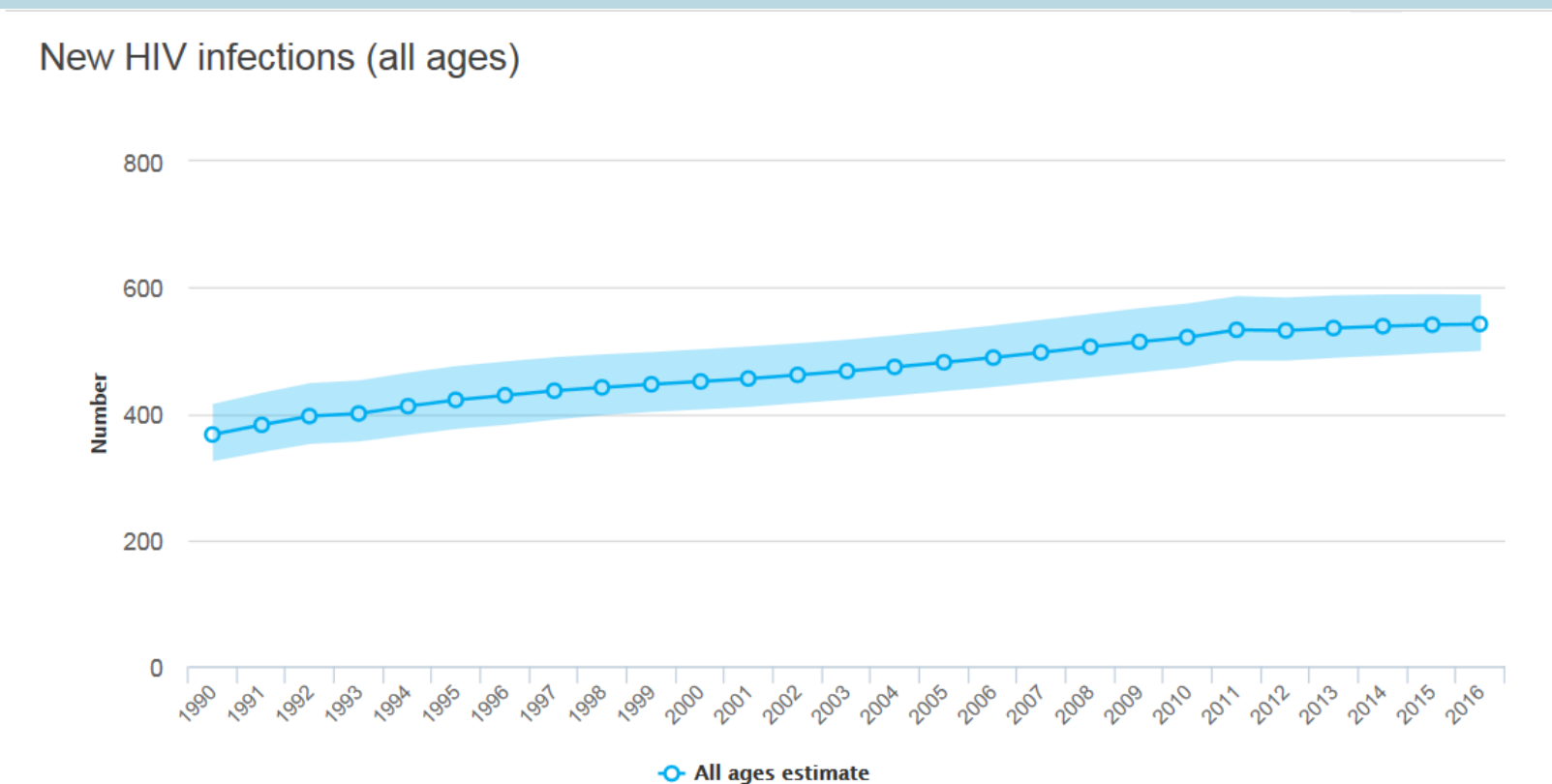
- Heterosexual 48 %

The country of origin

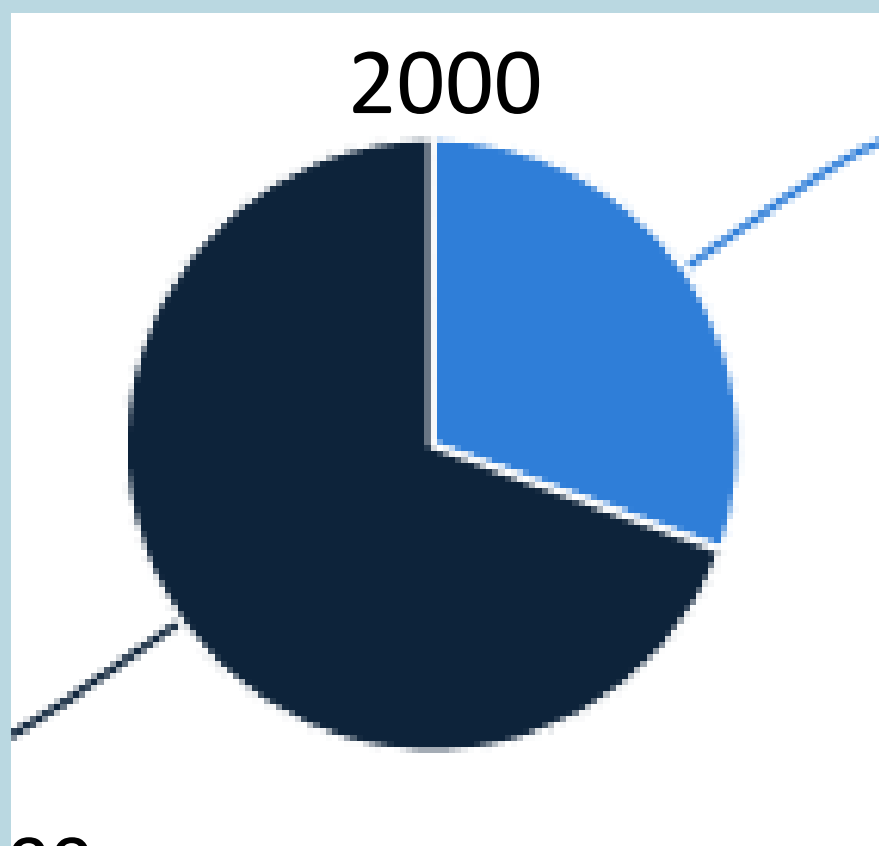


The majority come from Thailand and Eritrea

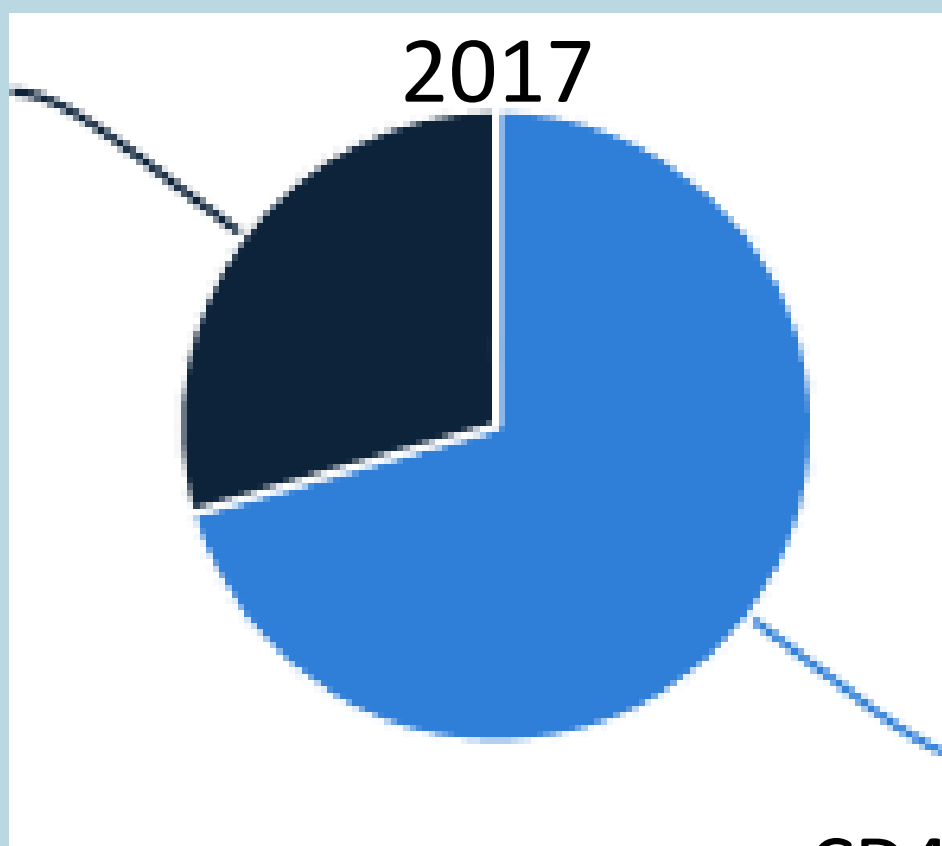

CD4<200 at diagnosis

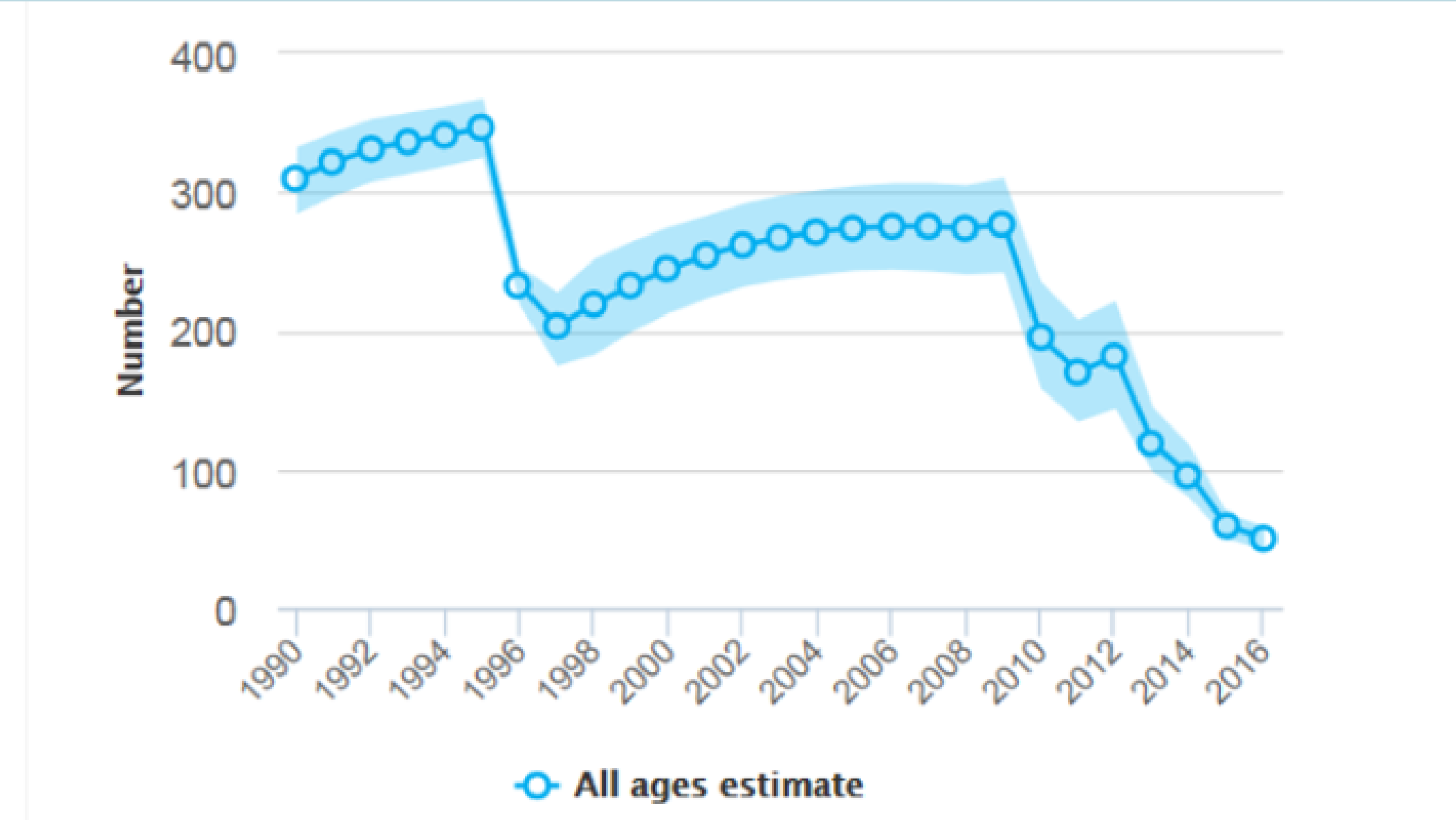


CD4 >200

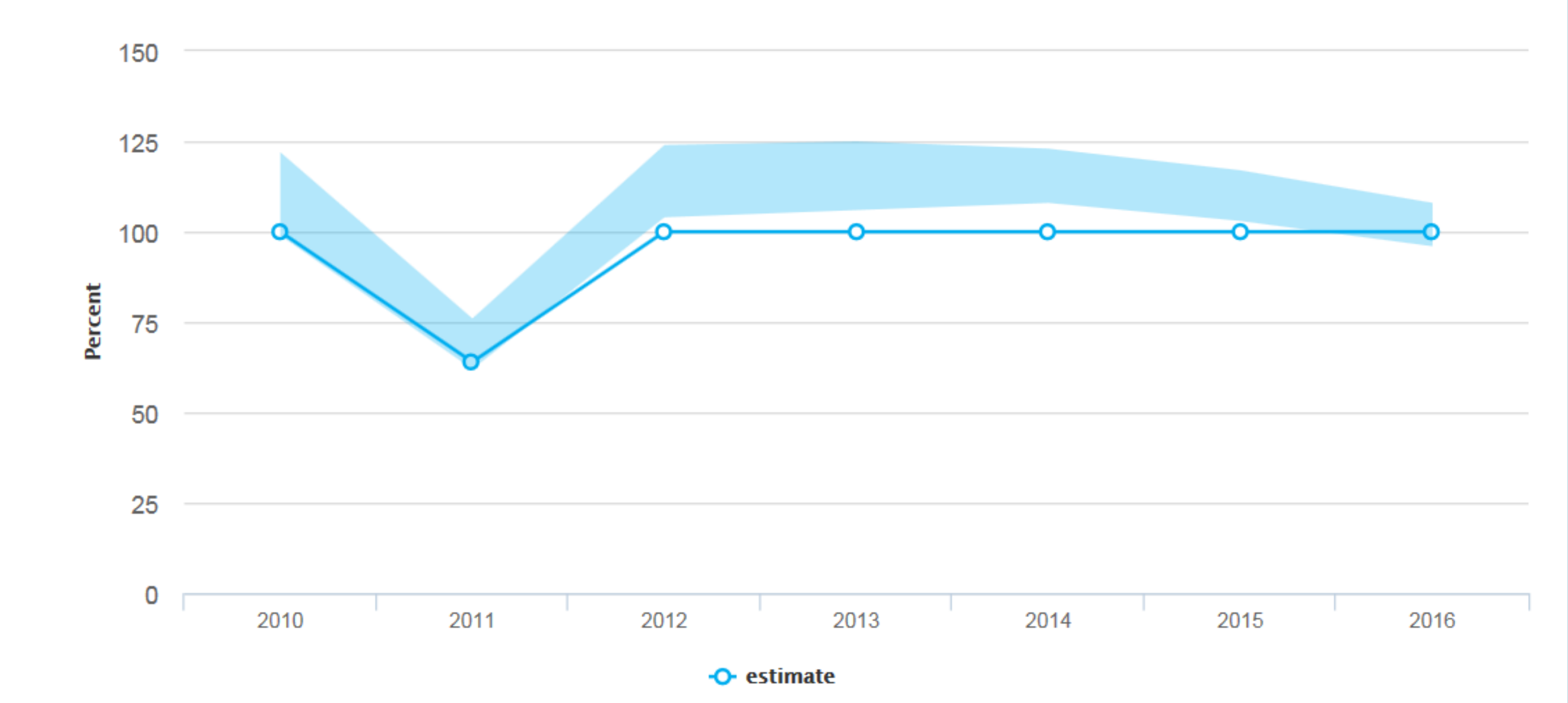


CD4 <200

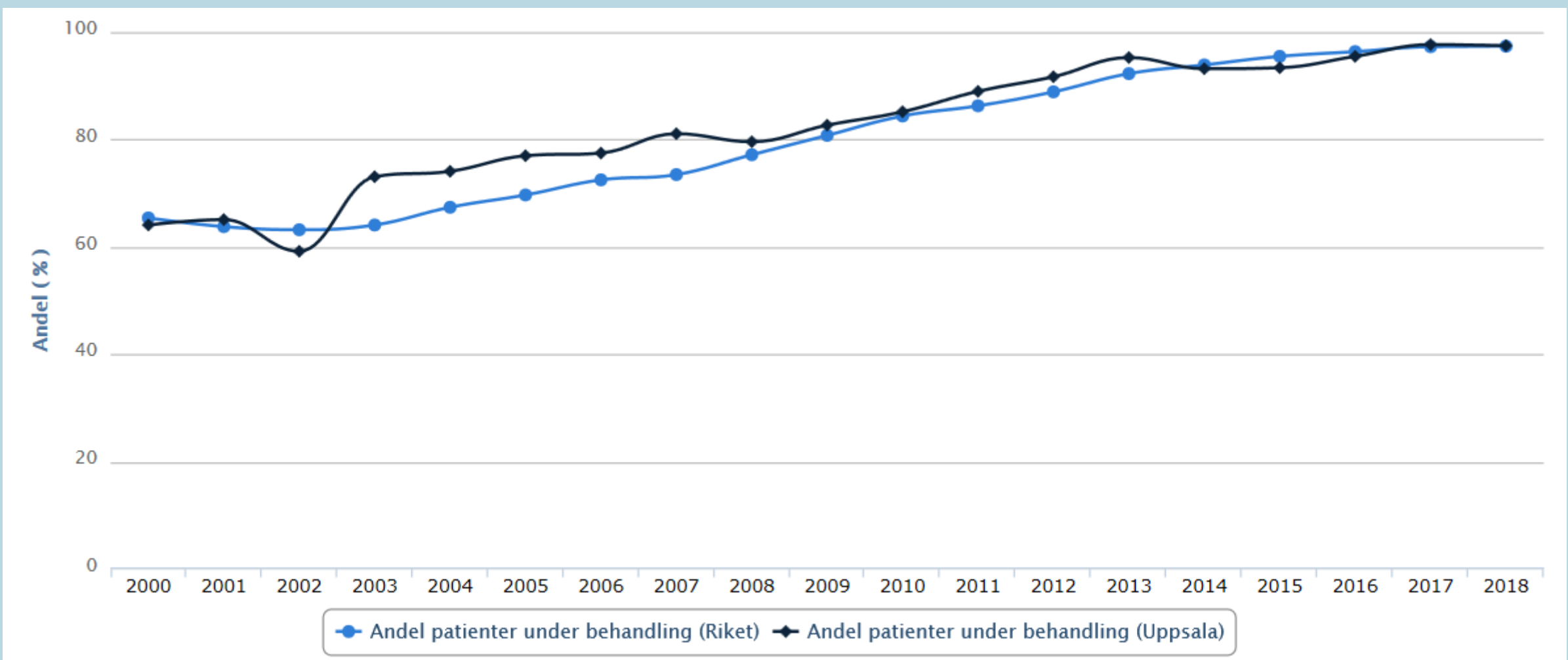
