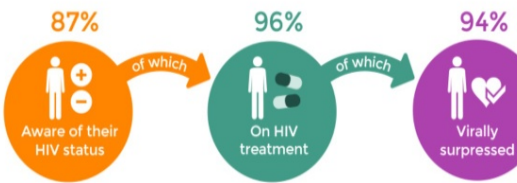

Hot Topics in the UK

Chem Sex

- Sexual activity under the influence of recreational drugs; usually in a group setting
- Increases risk of HIV/BBV acquisition

In HIV negative MSM

- 12% drug use in last 3 months, 5% during last time sex (GUMCAD 2016)
- 54% engaged in Chemsex in last 3 months (PROUD 2016)

PrEP

- Known to reduce risk of acquisition of HIV by 86% (Proud and Ipergay 2016)
- Currently NHS England "can fund" but will they?

- 7.96% black African
- 69.23% MSM
- Co-infection: HBV 3.19%, HCV 3.16%
- Route of transmission: 77.1% MSM, 11.25% heterosexual, 1.05% IVDU, 0.17% MTCT

- 3209 patients total
- Age range 16-85, median 47
- 76% male, 24% female
- Co-infection: 4% HBV, 5% HCV
- 24% Black African
- 56% MSM
- Route of transmission: 58% MSM, 34% heterosexual, 5% mother to child, 0.16% IVDU

Royal Cornwall Hospitals NHS Trust

- 222 patients
- Age Range 18-86. Median Age 49
- 4% Black African
- 23.5% (53) Female
- Co-infection: HCV 9.8%, HBV 1.3%
- Mode of transmission in majority (57%) = MSM

- 2456 patients
- Age range 4-89yo, median 45yo
- 45% Black African
- 39% Female
- Co-infection: 4.8% HBV, 6.6% HCV
- Mode of transmission in majority (59%) = Heterosexual sex
- 3.3% = vertical transmission
