

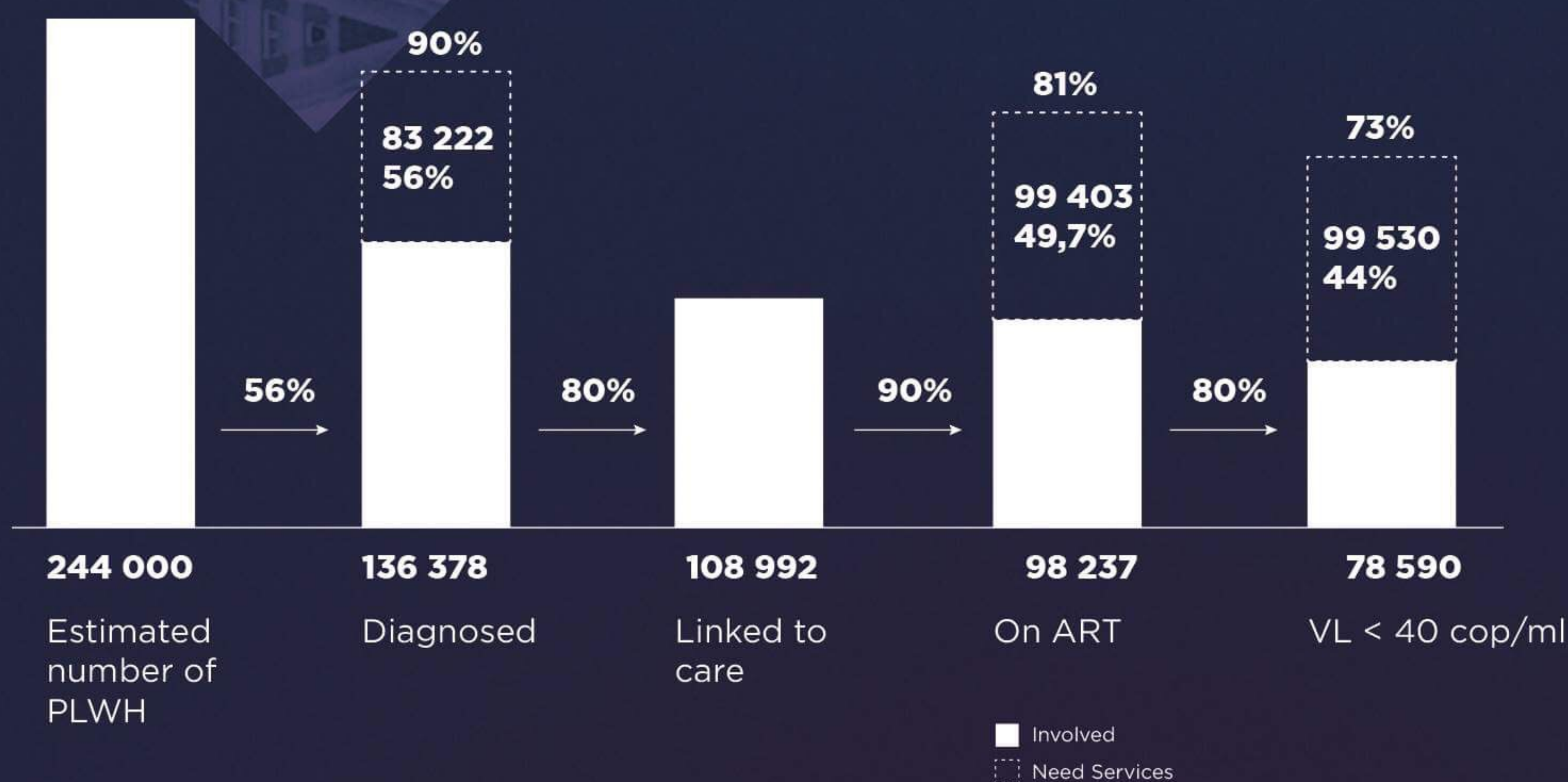
ACTUAL HIV/AIDS SITUATION IN UKRAINE

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL DATA AS OF 01.01.2018

NATIONAL HIV CASCADE*

PLWH REPRESENT 0,30% OF THE TOTAL POPULATION OF THE COUNTRY OR 0,53% AT THE AGE GROUP 15-49

* without taking into account the data of the temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, the city of Sevastopol from 2014 and part of the holding area anti-terrorist operation from 2015.



CHALLENGES

War (ATO area): HIV in the situation of armed conflict
The armed conflict in the East of Ukraine affected the territory with the high HIV burden,

On ART - 10,147 PLHIV,
including children

Gradual increase in the number of HIV cases among MSM, low availability of HIV services in this group.

The increase of the HIV incidence: 2001 - 700; 2017 - 18 194.

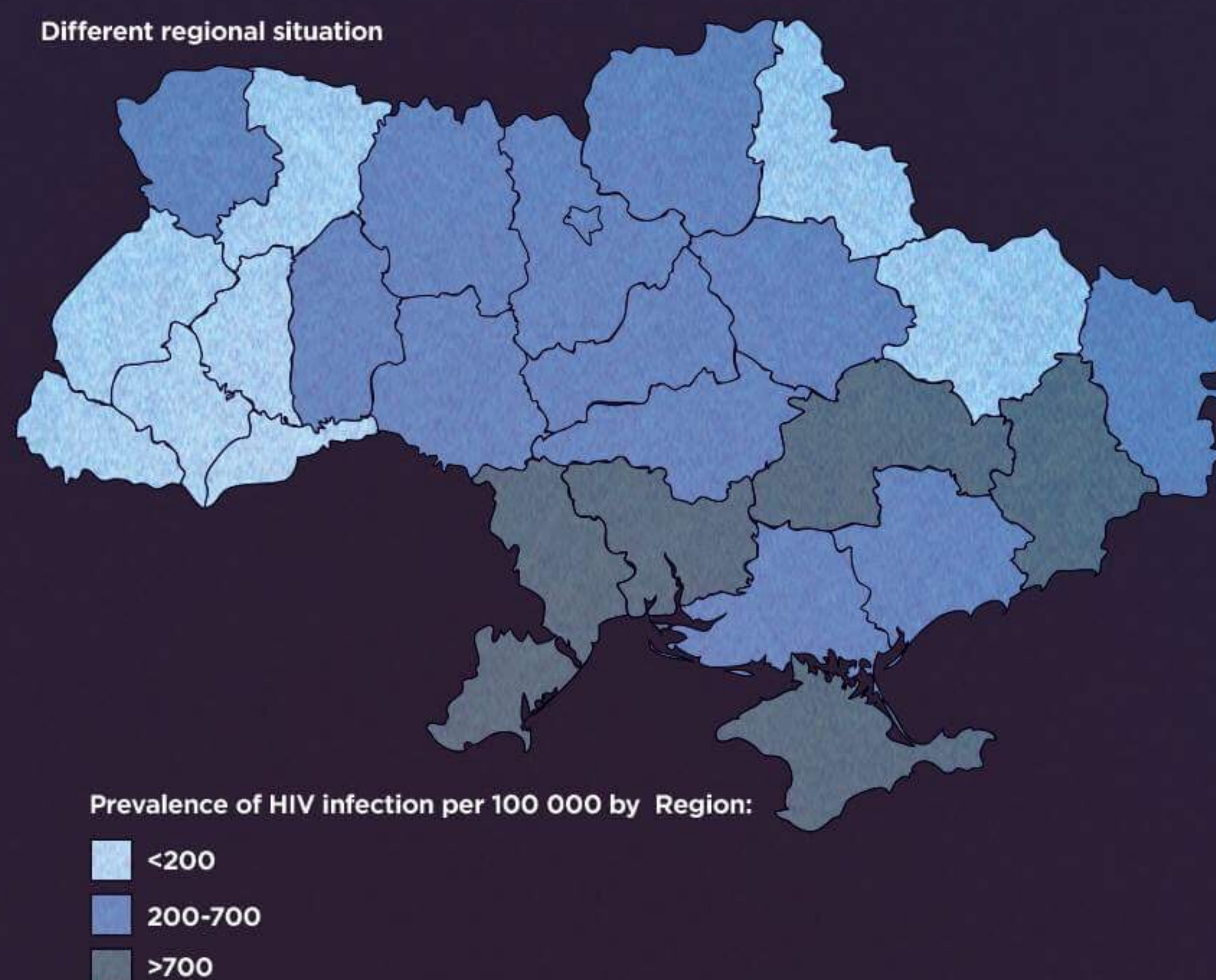
56.4% HIV cases
were detected on the 3rd and 4th clinical stages in 2017 (55,6 - 2016)

Ukraine carries a high burden of TB and ranks the 4th in the world with MDR-TB burden Tuberculosis remains the main cause of death among PLHIV (50%)

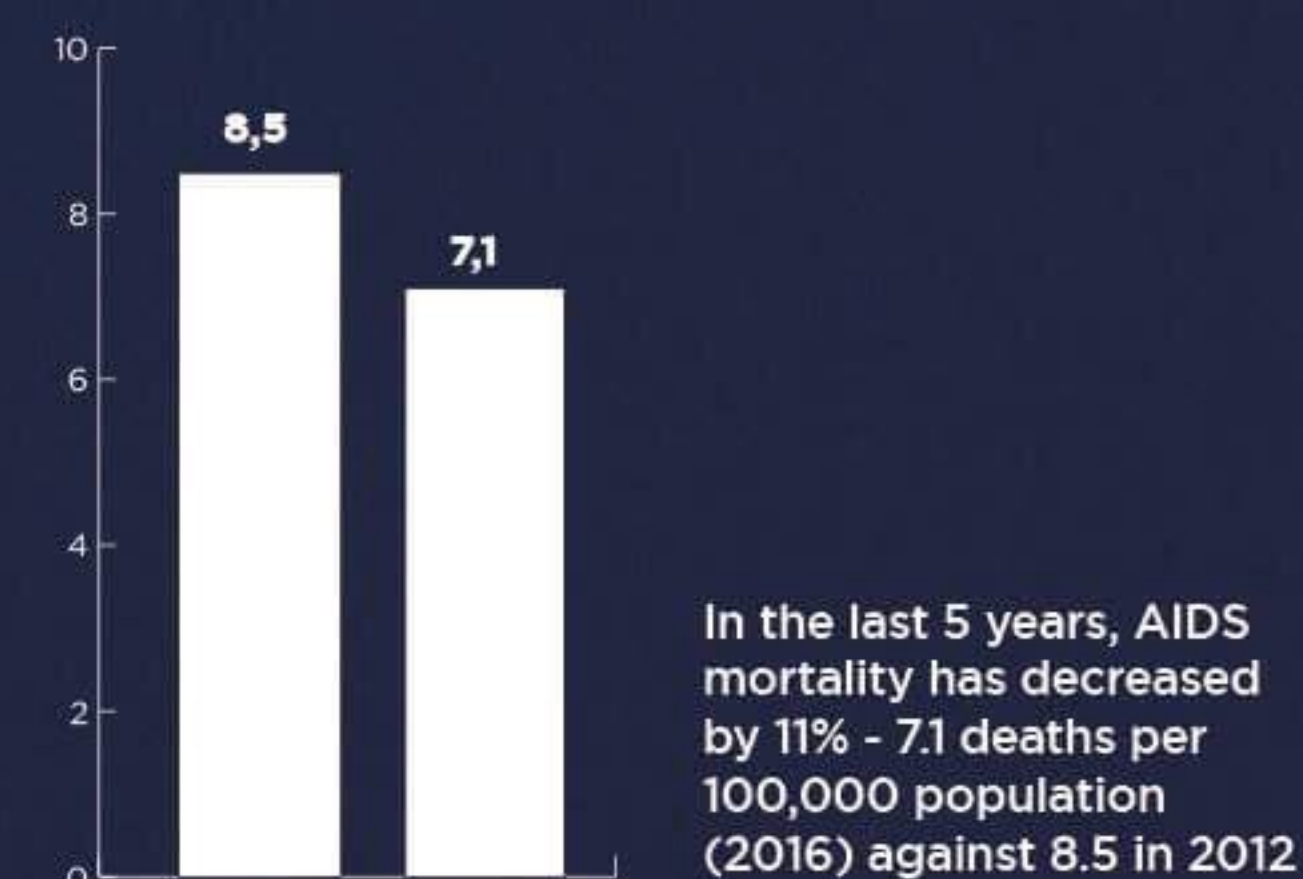
The expense of undiagnosed patients with HIV: 25-30% of HIV-positive people identified by data laboratory studies are not involved in medical supervision

Within the ART optimization efforts
Dolutegravir available for Ukraine at low cost.

The PHC supported by international partners (WHO, UNAIDS, UNICEF, PEPFAR, GFATM) has succeeded in ensuring consensus that ART procurements use progressively optimized ART regimens, and for all new patients.

To ensure universal access to ART across the country, decentralization processes are in progress
