







Routs of transmission










National HIV cascade 01.01.2019



ACHIEVEMENTS

- •Implementation «test and treat care» (average time from diagnostic to treatment start -15 days)
- •ART optimization (switching regimen from PI on DTG)
- Network of «AIDS -centers» in each region and «trust cabinets»
- •ART decentralization: 330 sites prescribe ART in Ukraine (01.01.2018) –universal access to ART
- •Integrated medical care for PLHIV (ART, OST, DAA for HCV treatment, in-site TB diagnostics LAM tests, GeneXpert)
- •OST program includes 11385 clients including 4660 HIV-positive,4087 87,7% on ART among them (01.01.2019),
- •Access to DAA treatment of HIV/HCV co-infected patients and high effectiveness of the treatment programs (94,8%)
- PrEP implementation in Ukraine for key HIV-negative population

CHALLENGES

DIRECT

- ●30% of people who lived with HIV don't know his/her status
- Near 50 % PLHIV are diagnosed with 3-4 HIV stage and CD4 cells less 350
- High burden of TB and MDR-TB –the main course of death in DI HIV
- Detection and registration of new cases of hepatitis B and C and also insufficient DAA treatment access for HCV

INDIRECT

- Reorganization of public health system
- Migration to other countries (working migrants make their input on HIV epidemic)
- Military conflict on the East of country (ART received 20265 PLHIV including children on uncontrolled Ukrainian torritories)
